	Students learn basics of phonology and orthography of Macedonian language (the sound system, pronunciation, stress, acquiring alphabet etc.); basics of morphology (nouns: gender, plural, definite article; personal pronouns, possessive pronouns and possessive adjectives, descriptive adjectives, numbers, prepositions, present tense of the most common verb groups, modal verbs, future tense, introduction of past tense, etc.) and acquiring limited number of grammatical structures and syntax of standard Macedonian language. All the grammar and topic-related vocabulary is acquired through its use in different communicative situations. Selected topics for discussion: identification and introduction, family relations, countries, nationalities, professions, food, clothes, weather, everyday activities, basic information about Macedonian culture etc.				
	Language functions: getting acquainted, welcoming, talking about oneself, describing people, asking questions, requesting, shopping, talking on phone, space orientation etc.
